## **Research Briefs**

Research Briefs are short publications prepared by the Department of Institutional Research and Effectiveness (IRE) that are intended to provide relevant information which assists in the performance improvement process used by St. Petersburg College (SPC). Research Brief topics include, but are not limited to, student achievement, state accountability measures, institutional survey results, student enrollment, and faculty/adjunct compensation.

## Introduction

In 1991, the Florida Legislature passed statewide accountability measures and defined state performance goals for each measure. College targets were also established. The five state wide measures are:

- 1. Enrollment of students entering the college relative to the previous year's high school graduates, retention of students (graduated or still enrolled) and student success (graduated, still enrolled or left in good standing);
- 2. Performance of A.A. degree transfers in the State University System (SUS);
- 3. Passing rates of students who completed vocational programs on state licensure tests and placement in related occupations;
- 4. Success of students who are required to take college preparatory courses (completion of preparatory courses, retention and success in college credit programs; and
- 5. Performance of students on the College Level Academic Skills Tests (CLAST) after they have completed 60 credit hours at the college.

Statewide and college performance data is made available from the state annually. The following table provides the state and St. Petersburg College's performance for the past five years along with the state and SPC targets for each of the five accountability measures.
