Our accreditation body, the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS), requires that all faculty, including adjunct faculty, engage in ongoing professional development to ensure our students receive the highest quality of instruction. To begin that professional development, all credit adjunct faculty (instructors, counselors, and librarians) must successfully complete an on-line initial training and orientation course provided by the College entitled *Excellence in Adjunct Instruction* prior to being considered for employment in a subsequent semester. Documented completion of prior adjunct training provided by the College (the *Excellence in Adjunct Instruction* video or the *Scenarios On-line* pilot) also fulfills this requirement. Documentation of other prior instruction on teaching skills may substitute for one or more of the course modules, as determined by your Dean or Program Director.

Non-credit adjuncts are only required to complete the Orientation and Technology modules to meet the training requirement. However, they are encouraged to explore the other modules for valuable teaching resources.
