



It was Florida's first two-year college (founded in 1927) as well as the state's first community college to offer bachelor's degrees in 2002. Today, SPC is a State College and serves as a model for incorporating bachelor's degree programs into traditional two-year institutions.

St. Petersburg College gives students a solid foundation for achievement and success in school and the workplace. With more than 130 academic programs and an innovative network of support and partnerships, SPC puts the dreams of its students within reach. 

SPC Facts

- > Type of institution: Public, non-profit college offering certificates, associates and bachelor's degrees. Master's and doctoral degrees are offered through SPC by partner universities and colleges.
- > Accreditation: SPC is accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS) to award associate degrees and bachelor's degrees. By law, an A.A. degree from SPC grants you admission as a junior to one of the state's public universities.
- > Enrollment: 64,000*
- *Credit and non-credit enrollment
- > Campuses: Four primary campuses and six additional learning sites located throughout Pinellas County.
- > Degree and certificate programs: More than 130.
- > Student activities: Student clubs and organizations available on every campus.
- > Athletics: Six varsity sports teams.
- > Opportunities: Honors College, University Partnership Center, Study Abroad, internships, veterans services, volunteer service and much more.

Highlights

- > Most recent survey of SPC graduates shows 98 percent would recommend St. Petersburg College to a friend.
- > SPC ranks 13th in the U.S. for associates degrees awarded.
- > SPC disbursed \$80 million in financial aid to students for the fall 2011 term, the largest such disbursement in the college's history.
- > The college ranks in the top 20 in the U.S. for four-year institutions awarding associate degrees to minority students.
- > The college ranks 4th in the U.S. for the number of associates degrees awarded annually in Nursing.
- > The college ranks 10th in the U.S. for the number of degrees awarded annually in health professions and related clinical services.
- > SPC has nearly 2,000 nurses in training.
- > More than 1,300 students are enrolled in teacher training.
- > The college's University Partnership Center offers more than 100 bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees.
- > The Leepa-Rattner Museum of Art, which won the Rowe Award for Excellence in Architecture, showcases 20th century artists Abraham Rattner, Allen Leepa, Esther Gentile and their contemporaries. The museum also was recently named one of the top 50 buildings in Florida as part of the Florida Association of the American Institute of Architects' Florida Architecture: 100 Years, 100 Places celebration.

- > The \$11-million Bankers Insurance Group building for the J.E. Hanger College of Orthotics and Prosthetics opened in 2008 at the Caruth Health Education Center.
- > The Palladium Theater at St. Petersburg College has been named the *Best Local Theater* by *Tampa Bay Metro Magazine* for a third year in a row.
- > SPC's \$10-million Veterinary Technology building opened in fall 2011 at its new location in Largo Florida.

 An anatomy lab and a clinical pathology lab are the focal point of this state-of-the-art facility.
- > SPC's new Institute for Strategic Policy Solutions supports and enhances the college's new Public Policy and Administration bachelor's program and offers students the opportunity to gain hands-on experience with experts through internships and foreign exchange opportunities.
- > The college's Associate of Science Degree in Engineering Technology—the first in Florida— has been adopted by 10 other colleges in the state and serves as a national model for other states.




