



1. How do I register for classes?

You can register by scheduling an appointment with an advisor at the Midtown Jamerson Center. Advisors are on campus Monday-Thursday 8:30 a.m.-7 p.m. and Friday 8:30 a.m.-noon

2. Who do I meet with to determine my financial aid package?

See Financial Aid Counselor Roslynn Kearney. She can be found at MTJC in the main office.

3. If I had/have an IEP or a disability, can I receive accommodations?

4. Where is the bookstore and their hours?

The campus bookstore is located on the first floor next to the library and is open Monday-Thursday 9 a.m.-5 p.m. **Students cannot purchase textbooks from the campus bookstore.**

5. How do I order textbooks?

Log into MySPC, Click "My Status" on the left, under "My Schedule" there is a textbook link. You can have textbooks delivered to your home or any SPC bookstore for pickup.

6. Where can I go to sit and relax? Is eating allowed on campus?

The Student Lounge is located on the third floor. Room 339 is the designated area for students to eat and consume beverages. A TV, computers, coffee, microwave, board games and couch seating are some of the amenities offered. More to come!

7. Where is the Lost and Found located?

To access the Lost and Found ask a security officer or Student Life Coordinator Jesus Soler in Room 339.

8. Where do I go to find out about campus events?

Most campus events should be located on your calendar in MyCourses. However, the best way to know what's happening on campus is by following the SPC Midtown Facebook page. If you do not have a Facebook grab a campus monthly calendar at the front desk or in the Student Lounge Room 339.

9. Is there a place to purchase food on campus?

Snacks can be purchased on the first floor in the campus bookstore. A food truck will also be made available on Wednesdays during lunch time (11 a.m.-2 p.m.) Most campus events also offer food that is free to SPC students with a Valid Student ID. See campus calendar for events.

10. Where is the library? What kind of help can I get there?

The library is located on the first floor through the sliding glass doors off the main lobby area. In the library, you can get help with research, citations, basic computer questions, MyCourses, and more. Math, Science, Writing tutors can be found on second floor MTJC 210.

11. How do I find out about work study?

Go to spcollege.edu, click "Financial Aid" on top of page, and click "Student Employment" on the left. There you will find a page to several student employment options

12. How do I start a club?
